Interns will be based at our field research camp on East Limestone Island, located just north of the Gwaii Haanas boundary in Haida Gwaii. Interns will be responsible for their own transportation to/from the Village of Queen Charlotte & food for 1 week (billeting provided). LBCS will arrange all food, transportation and lodging for the duration of the field component of the internship (5 weeks).
